ANSWER

COMES NOW respondent Freeman Bosley, Jr., by and through his undersigned attorneys at Armstrong Teasdale LLP, and for his Answer to the Information states as follows:

Mr. Bosley and his law firm Bosley & Associates, LLC have been blessed with a substantial and rapidly expanding number of clients and growing opportunities to assist persons and companies with legal needs in St. Louis City, St. Louis County, and surrounding areas. 
